Points for Prayer

Reflections

Sunday 6th April

Read Colossians 1:9. Who sits beside us in church? The pews in front, behind and to the side. When was the last time we prayed for the people who sit around us? Take time today to think about our neighbours in church and pray for them. Thank God for them and pray that they will be filled with the knowledge of his will.

Monday 7th April

Read James 4: 13-17. What are our plans for this week? What is the main event that is occupying our thoughts? Take time and pray about that. Seek God's will, ask that his timing would be evident, that his purpose and his glory will be revealed.

Tuesday 8th April

Read 1 Peter 3:15. What are the opportunities before us this week to witness to the goodness of God and the gospel of Jesus Christ? Have we thought about how we might talk to those we meet about Jesus? Why not ask God to direct us to a scripture that we can carry with us this week and use to talk about Jesus.

Wednesday 9th April

Read Luke 12: 11-12: Very often it is fear that holds us back from talking about Jesus. We worry about being made to look daft or not being able to answer a question. Jesus told his disciples not to worry because the Spirit will give the words at the right time. Take time this morning to pray that we would know the power of the Spirit and the confidence of the Spirit in our lives to talk about Jesus.

Thursday 10th April

Read Acts 8: 26-40. It was the Spirit of God who very clearly took Philip to the road where he would meet the Ethiopian Eunuch. Have we ever asked God to direct our paths in this

way, that he would lead us to the people he would have us talk to? Take time today to pray for God's leading in who he would have us speak to.

Friday 11th April

Read Acts 8: 1-3: The stoning of Stephen and a wider persecution of the church did not stop the good news of Jesus spreading, it actually helped because as Christians fled, they talked to everyone they met about Jesus. Don't let rejection or opposition stop us from talking about Jesus, it could simply be this is how God will enable more people to hear the good news.

Saturday 12th April

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:11. As we prepare to meet for worship tomorrow, how can we best encourage one another? We started the week by praying for one another, take time today to pray again for the people who sit around us and ask God how we can be an encouragement to those people.
