Points for Prayer

Sunday 1st June

Read Revelation 5:12. Worthy is the Lamb who was slaughtered to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honour and glory and blessing! Jesus is worthy, reflect on what it means for us to give him power, riches, wisdom, strength, honour, glory and blessing. How do we give to God, not just on a Sunday but through every day of our lives.

Monday 2nd June

Read 2 Kings 23:12-14. The king tore down the altars... King Josiah introduced religious reform to Judah at a time when the books of the law had been so forgotten by the people and society they were lost in the back of the temple and hadn't been read for generations. Josiah had the law read; he tore down altars to false gods. Do we need to rediscover the word of God in our lives, are there idols we need to tear down? Take time today to reflect on how we worship God.

Tuesday 3rd June

Read 1 Samuel 4:3. Why did the Lord defeat us today before the Philistines? Let's bring the ark of the Lord's covenant from Shiloh. Then it will go with us and save us from our enemies. The Ark did not save Israel. They had treated the things of God as a lucky charm. They trusted in the thing and not in God. Have we allowed religious things, religious practices to take the place of trusting in Christ, to replace our worship of God? Take time today to simply be with God. Set aside everything else and simply pray and sit in the presence of the Lord. Listen for his voice in the stillness.

Wednesday 4th June

Read Acts 19:2. Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed? It is true and can never be denied that the Spirit of God dwells in the lives and hearts of all believers. Yet it is also true to say that believers should be seeking even more of the Spirit in our lives, we should be asking not just to be filled but that the Spirit would flow out from us. Have we received this overflowing of the Spirit? In the quietness of our time with God today ask that we overflow with the power of his Spirit.

Thursday 5th June

Read 1 Thessalonians 5:17. **Pray constantly.** This verse is wonderfully clear. Pray constantly. It is good and important that we have our own times of prayer, but it is equally important that we come together to pray. Plan to come to church earlier on Sunday to be part of the prayer time at 10:00 am.

Friday 6th June

Read Isaiah 52:7. **How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of the herald...** For many of us today is the last working day of the week. Take the opportunity today to invite someone you work with to come to church with you on Sunday.

Saturday 7th June

Read Proverbs 4:23. Guard your hearts above all else, for it is the source of life. This morning our elders meet for prayer. Please pray for our church leaders, pray that their hearts would be guarded, that they would remain close to the Lord and that they would be led by the Lord.
